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



In historical terms, low approval ratings for **Trump's transition**


% who approve of the job has done % who approve of cabinet choices explaining their politics and plans and other high level appointments






Deeply divided reactions to the transition


% who approve of the job _____ has done explaining their policies and plans for the future to the American people...






Modest enthusiasm for Trump's cabinet choices and other major appointments




Public views Trump as 'patriotic,' but also as 'hard to like,' 'reckless'

% who say each of the following describes Trump ...




About half of Republicans say Trump is 'hard to like'

% who say each of the following describes Trump ...




Most are concerned over Trump's ties to businesses, foreign governments

Republicans, Democrats want Trump to be 'more cautious' in the White House


When it comes to the kind of things Trump says and tweets, once he becomes president ... (%)


Immigrants are seen as more of a strength than a burden

% who say immigrants today ...




What should Congress do with the health care law now?



Among Democratic and Democratic-leaning voters



Little change in views of national economy


Economic conditions in the country today are ... (%)


A FINAL LOOK AT CAMPAIGN 2016

No single factor behind Trump's win: Here are some (but not all)

- Public unhappiness with both candidates, but partisan polarization guaranteed Trump a solid floor
- Mood of the country inhospitable to a "continuity" candidate, more open to a change agent
- Economic anxieties, especially among the white working class
- Racial resentments
- The "emerging Democratic majority" didn't emerge enough
- Weak parties, changes in journalism and rise of social media

Compared with 50 years ago, life for people like you in America today is ...





- Demographic change really is happening


Republicans still opt for conservative direction
