


Do you feel things in this country are going in the right direction, or do you feel things have gotten off on the wrong track?








Do you approve or disapprove of the job that Donald Trump is doing as President?








And which issue do you think is next most important for Congress and the President to reach an agreement on ?



As you may already know, the federal government is currently under a partial shutdown. In your view, who is most responsible for this partial federal government shutdown? Would you say it is:




In general, do you think that the federal government is...part of the solution, or part of the problem - for challenges facing you and your family today?








Do you think that the federal government is doing...too much, the right amount, or not enough to solve the problems facing the country?











And which area do you think is next most important?



Would you like to see more involvement or less involvement from the government in healthcare?









Do you think this trade dispute is going to have a positive or negative impact on your personal financial situation? Or do you think this trade dispute is not going to have an impact on your personal finances?







Some people say that America is best when it acts alone on economic and defense issues, is not bound by international agreements, and puts the wellbeing of its own citizens above the rest of the world.


Other people say that America is best when it works closely with our allies to increase global prosperity and defend freedom against global threats.
