








Do you feel things in this country are going in the right direction, or do you feel things








Now I would like to read you a list of issues that Congress and the President could deal with. Please listen as I read the list and tell me which one issue you think is most important for Congress and the President to deal with.








Would you like to see the President and Congress work together more closely to solve important problems facing this country?






In your view, who or what is most responsible for the current state of the national economy?




Have you or anyone in your immediate family been furloughed, suspended, otherwise told not to work, or lost your job since the beginning of the COVID-19 crisis in March?



As you may already know, the Congress passed and President Trump signed into law several programs to help deal with the economic impact of the COVID-19 crisis.


One of these programs was called the Paycheck Protection Program which allowed many businesses to receive low interest loans in return for not laying off employees.

Were you personally or do you know someone whose job was saved by this program?






Have you yourself or someone you know been diagnosed as positive for COVID-19?


If a COVID-19 vaccine is widely available in spring 2021 at little to no cost to you, do you think that you would take this vaccine?








