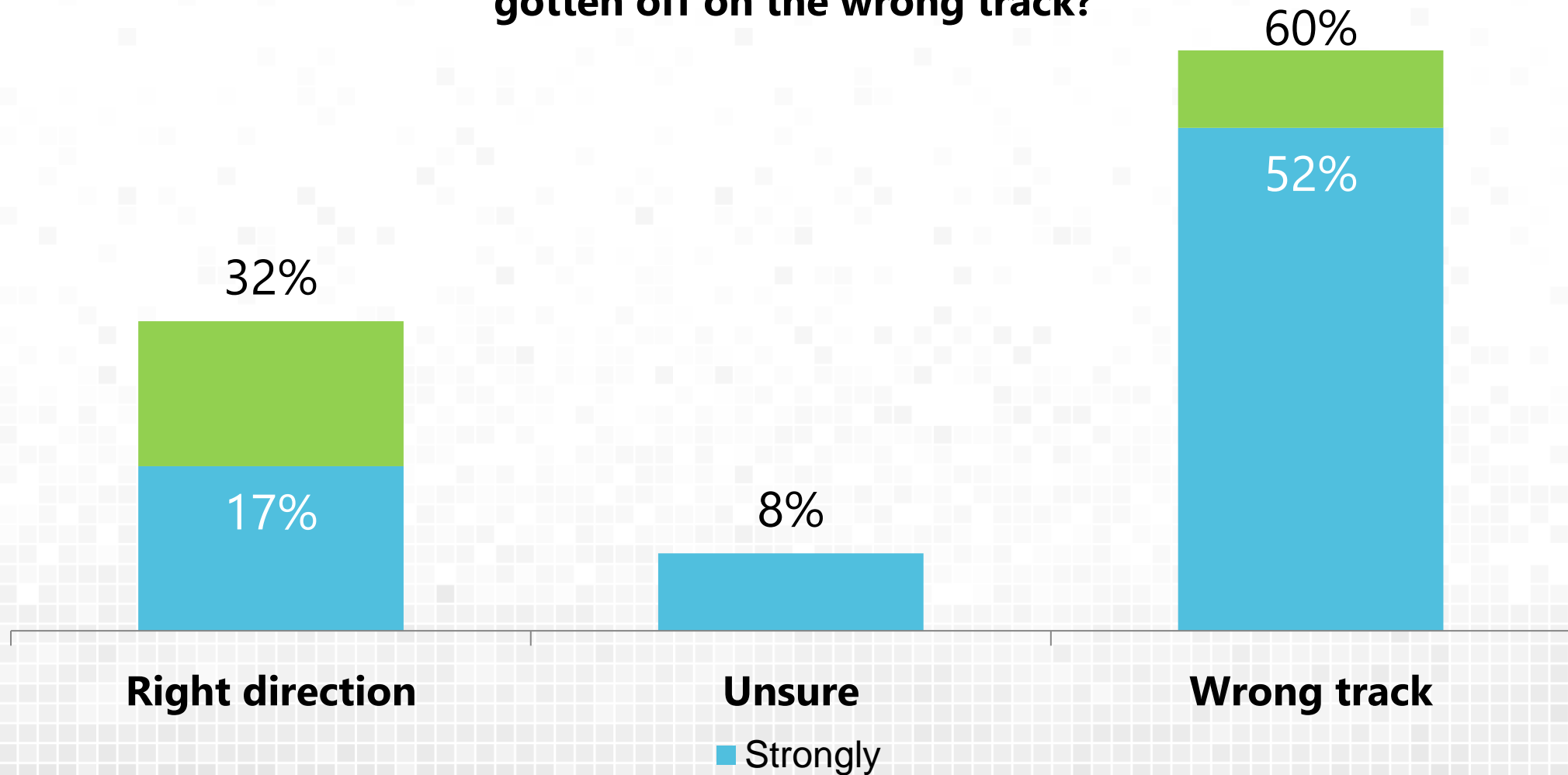


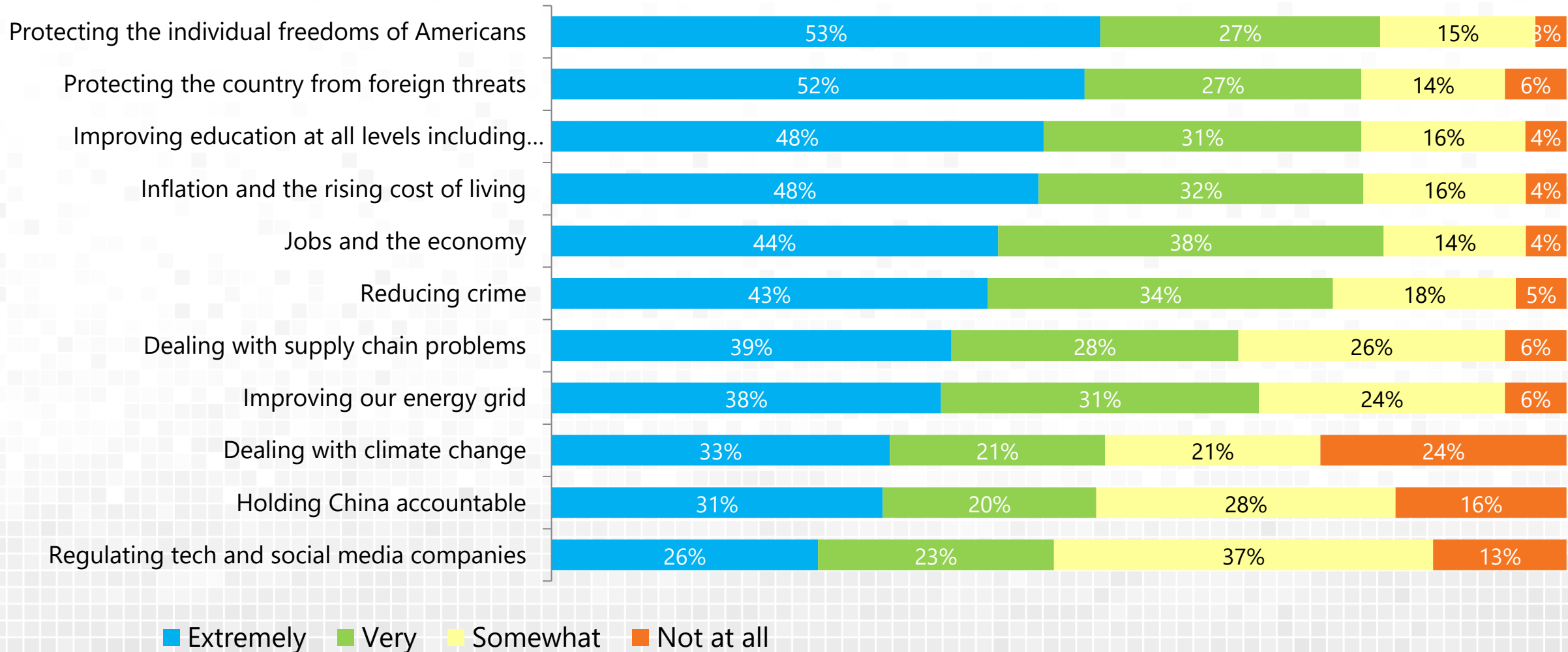

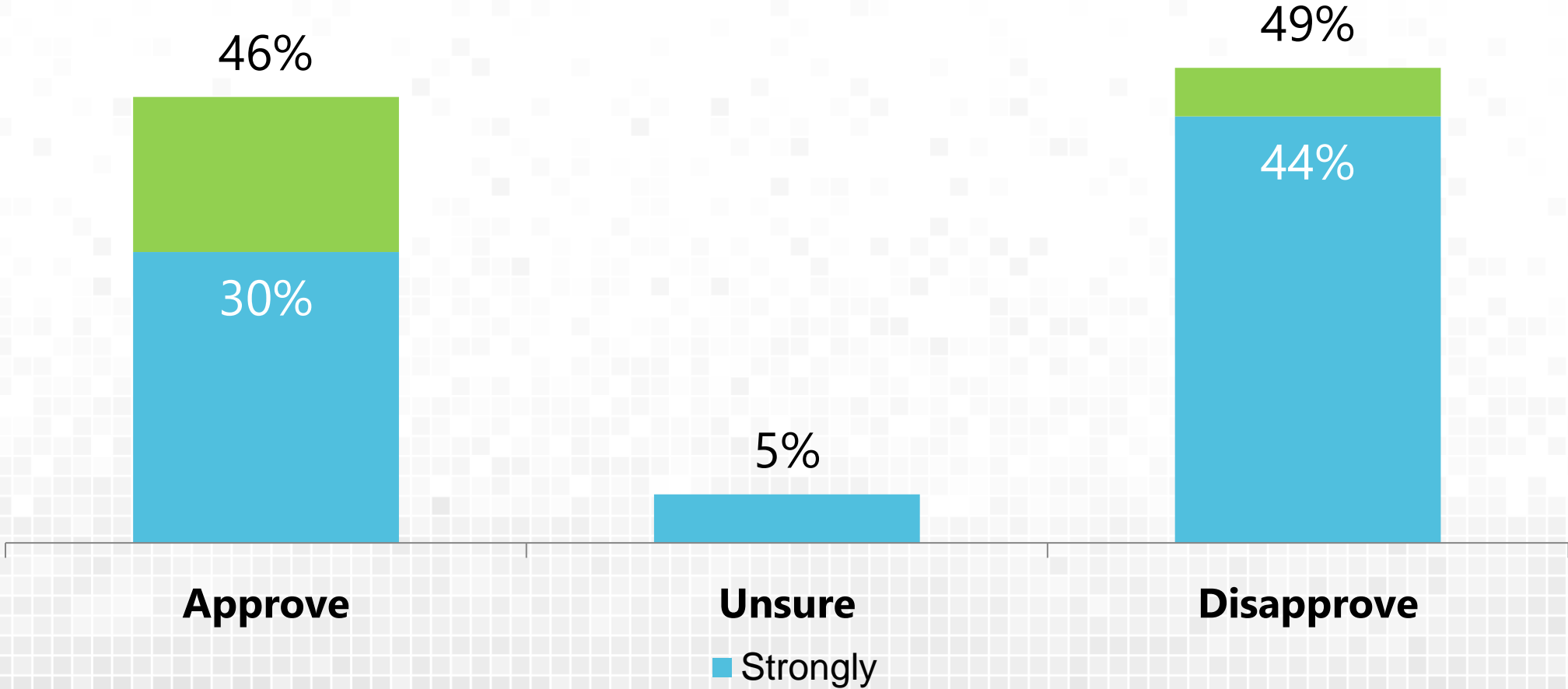
**Now, thinking for a moment about things in the country--

gotten off on the wrong track?**



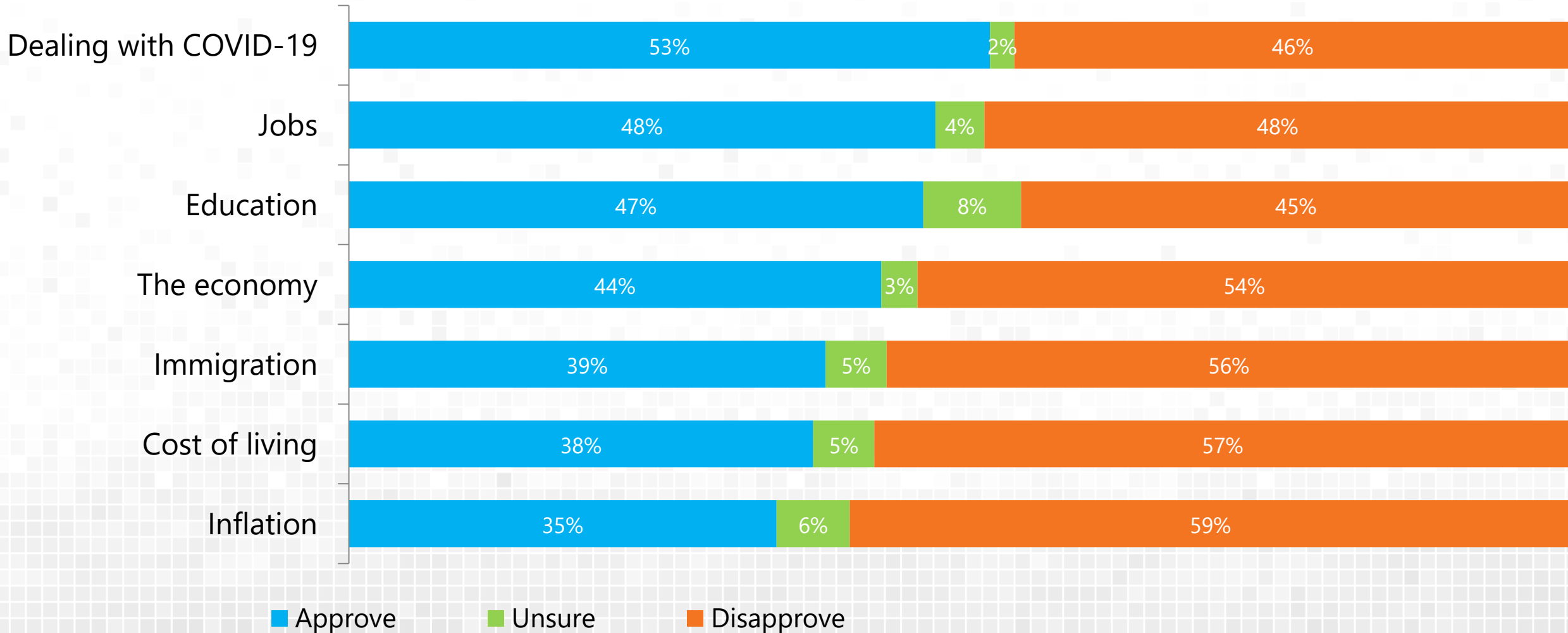

How would you rate the job Joe Biden has been doing as President? Do you approve or disapprove of the job he is doing?

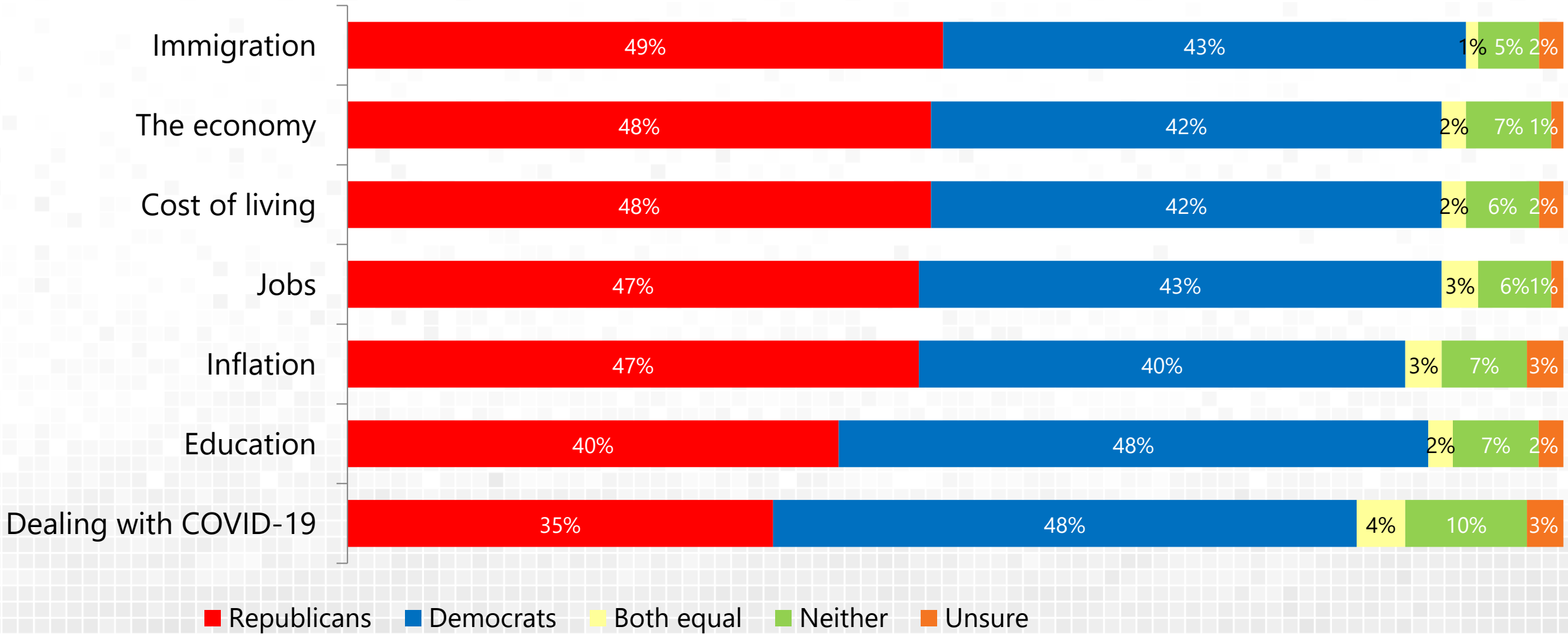

Now, thinking about these issues in a different way...

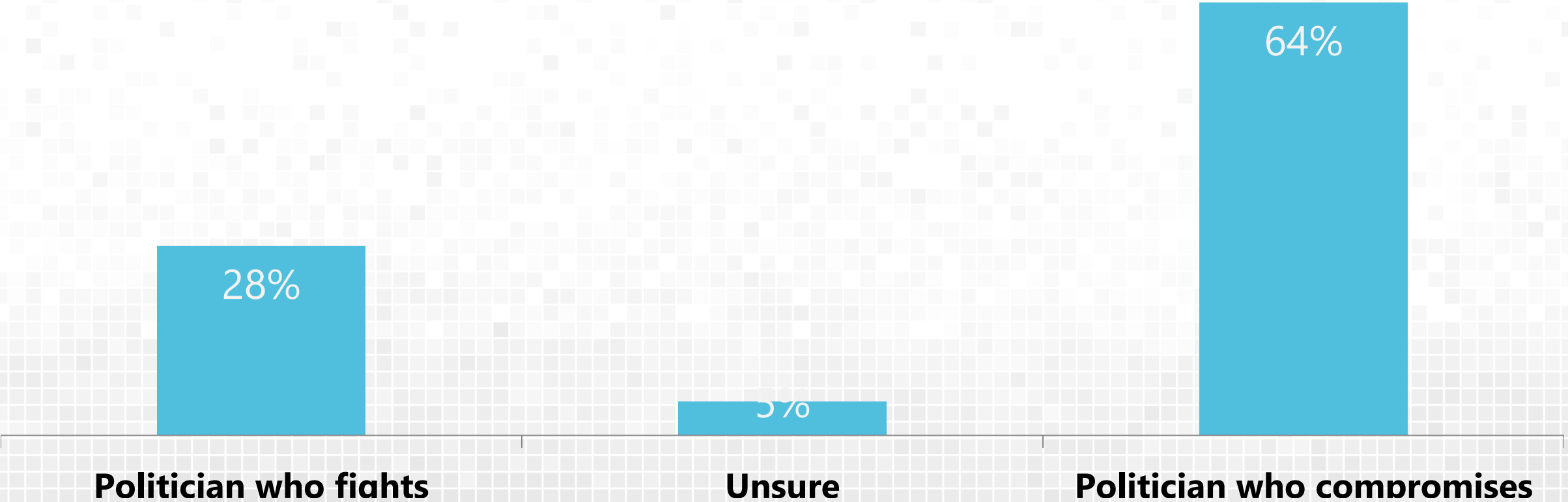

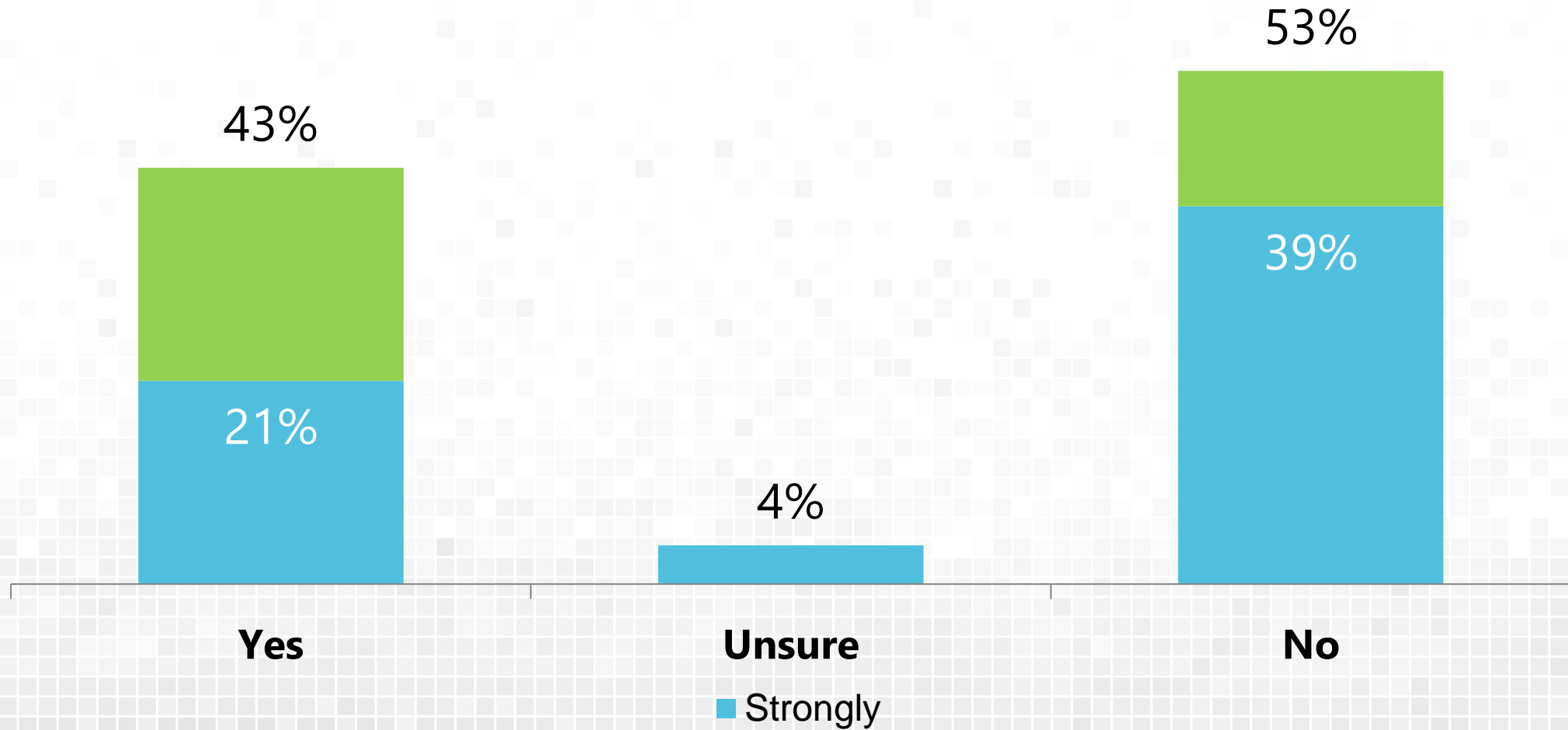
VIEW OF WASHINGTON LEADERS

Do you believe the federal government meets your needs and the needs of your family?



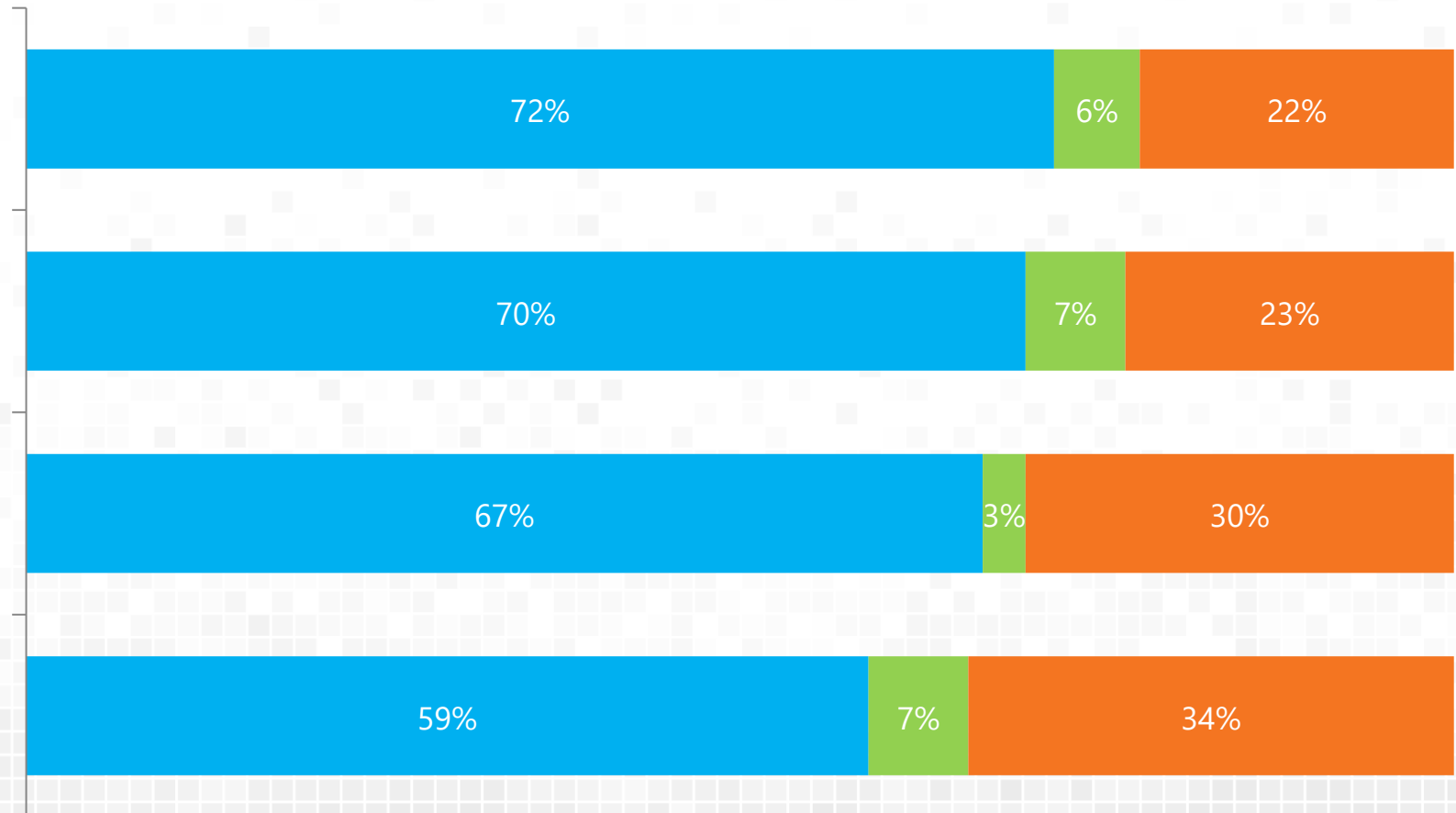
Now, I would like to read you a list of proposals. Please listen carefully as I read each proposal and tell me if you would favor or oppose that particular proposal.

Reforming the tax code to make certain wealthy individuals and corporations pay more in taxes.

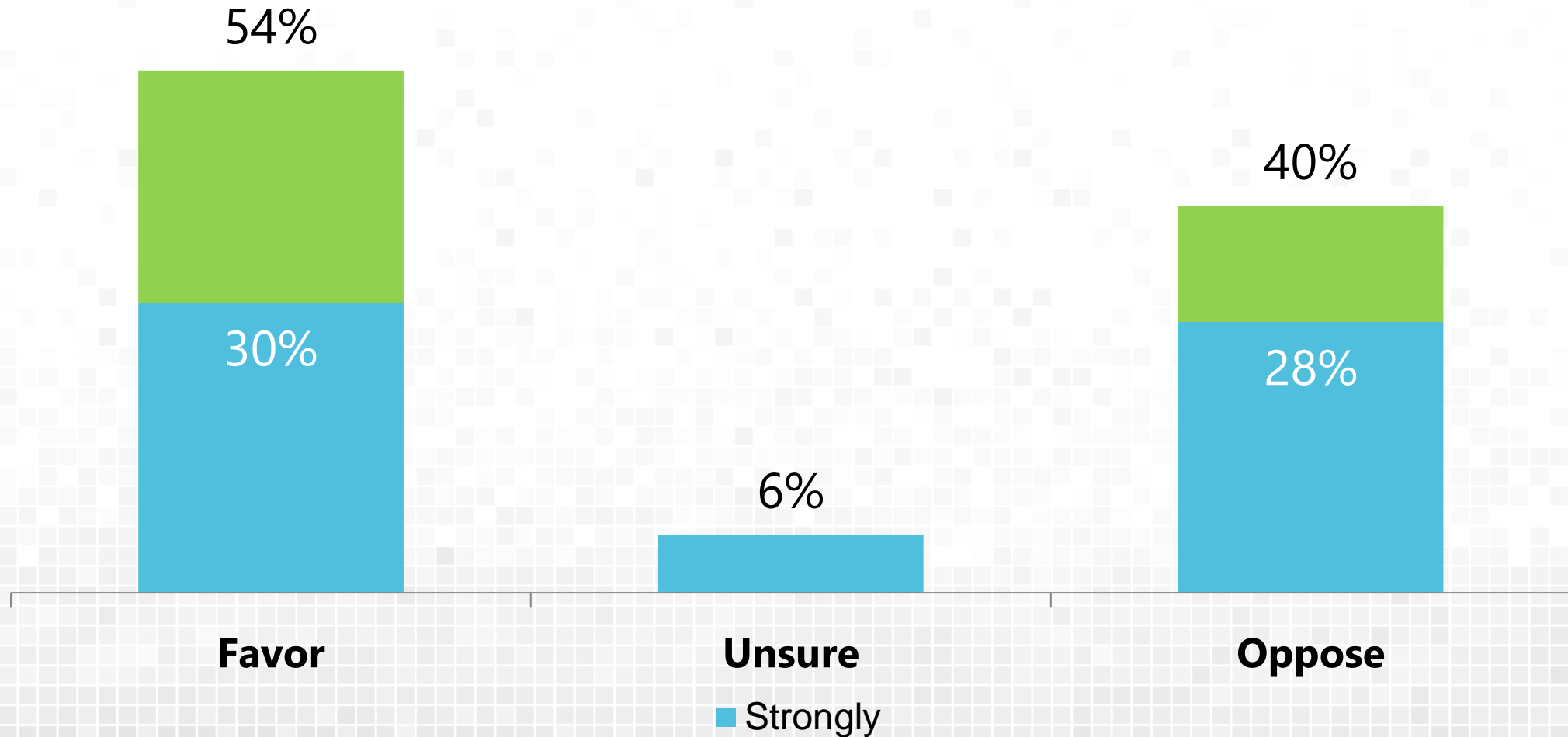
Experiment with a performance-based funding model in K-12 education, rewarding schools for producing successful graduates.



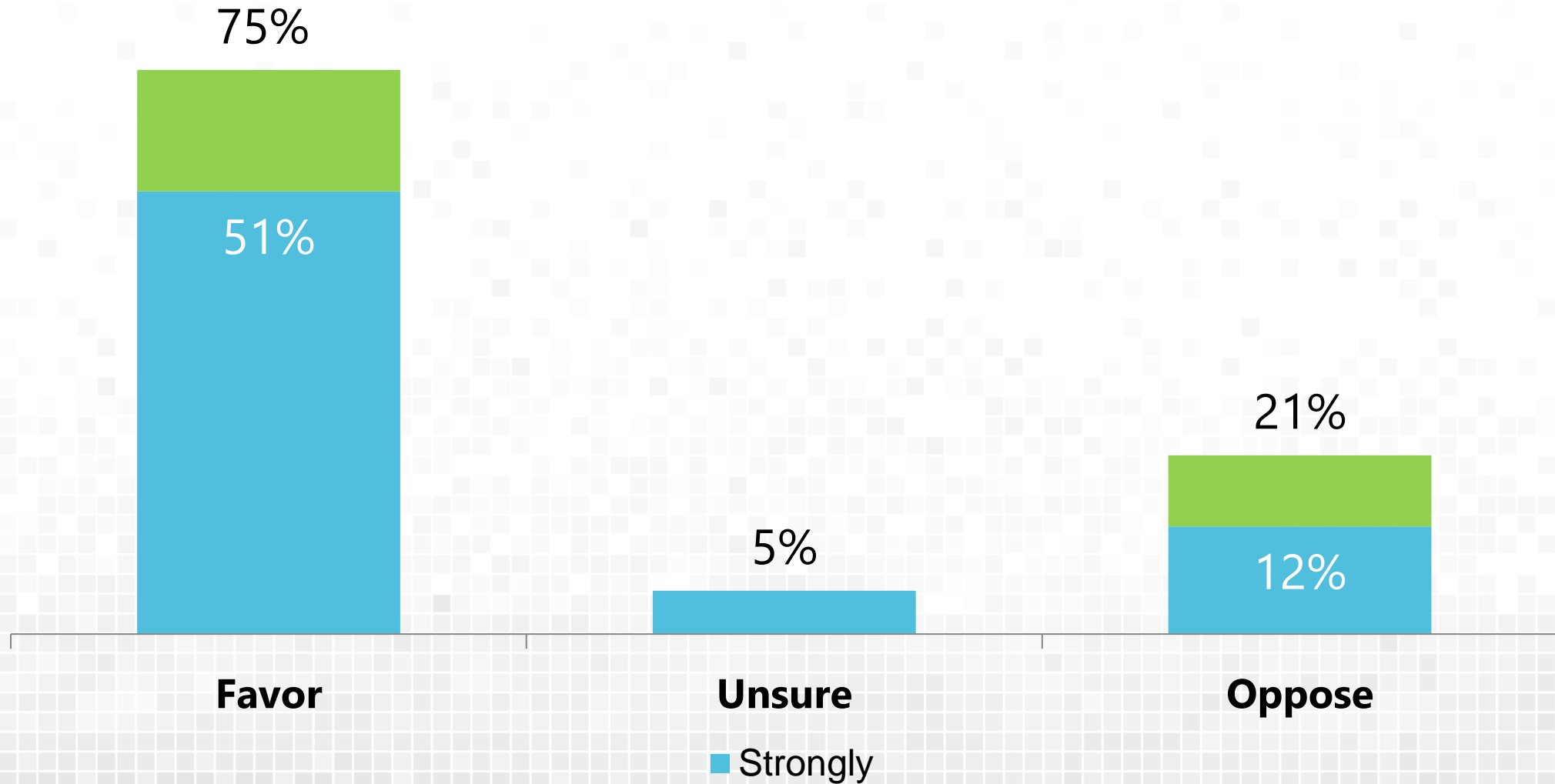
■ Favor ■ Unsure ■ Oppose
